- A. Nottoway County School Board – Call To Order – Jamie Higgins, Vice-Chair
- B. Nottoway County Board of Supervisors – Call To Order – Helen Simmons, Chair
- C. ELECTRONIC PARTICIPATION APPROVAL – Outlaw moved to approve Jimmy Fowlkes and Shelli Hinton to participate electronically due to quarantine. Pettis seconded. All in favor.

Point of Order – John Roark make a motion to adjourn this meeting until we have proper recording for the public. No second. Motion failed.

Agenda Item #2 – MOMENT OF SILENCE / PRAYER and PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Agenda Item #3 – APPROVAL OF AGENDA – Pettis made a motion to approve. Outlaw seconded. All in favor.

Point of Clarification – Steve Bowen asked if the Board of Supervisors need to make a motion to approve the agenda.

Mr. Roark answered Yes. Bowen made the motion to approve. Roark seconded. All in favor.

Agenda Item #4 – WORK SESSION

- A. ANTC – Discussion: the budget, the agreement and the proposed programs. There is a joint board meeting with ACPS and NCPS. Discussion was made regarding the agreement (Pg. 7) if a school division withdraws. Nottoway’s total operating cost if we did not have Amelia - \$858,154.82 to run as is. Add funding for PAS \$1,326,262. Including making CNA full time and adding culinary arts.
 - Community College vs. ANTC was discussed.
 - Nottoway’s plan if Amelia pulls out. To take care of the students and afford an opportunity to learn a trade. Enrollment: Nottoway has 43, Amelia has 25 and Cumberland has 2.

- Marcia Martin discussed the funds and grant funds for ANTC.
 - One board cannot obligate another board.
 - Suggest a 5 and 10 year plan.
 - If Amelia pulls out, the program could possibly come to BES and could be a functional trade school.
 - Roanoke Rapids, NC has a CTE program. The facility was toured. They have a variety of programs offered to students.
 - Nottoway does have to find where to place our PAS students.
 - Some would like BES as a viable CTE program for the county, if Amelia pulls out.
- B. BES – Discussion: We are educating the BOS and to be open in the event Amelia decides not to come back. After the Nov. 30th joint meeting, we will be able to project and communicate with the BOS.

We hope this is one of many meetings with SB and BOS to discuss the future of ANTC.

Summarize:

ANTC is a program we want to move forward whether at Jetersville or Burkeville. We want to give our students a chance. After Nov. 30th, we will have a better understanding. This is information so you are not blindsided.

Other:

Payment twice a month. John Roark asked for a straw pole. – personal opinion would like to push for this happen. Shelli suggests surveying the teachers again.
